Spondon Community Association has been in existence since 1977. The Village Improvement Committee started in 2001, entering East Midlands in Bloom in 2004, winning that and subsequently in 2006, 2007 and 2009. We won Britain in Bloom in 2005 and gained a silver award in 2010.

In addition to their chosen “good cause” Safari Stops are asked to make a donation to the Village Improvement Committee. In 2012, the Safari raised over £650 for the Village Improvement Committee and £1700 for the participant’s chosen causes.

As well as the Safari stops, you can visit Spondon’s open spaces which are open all the time:

- X. Sensory Garden, Chapel Street. Runner-up in the 2012 RHS Britain in Bloom “Community Space” category and site of the new tree sculpture.
- Y. Dale Road Park. Site of the new toposcope, officially opened on Saturday 13th July
- Z. West Park Meadow Local Nature Reserve, access via Park Road or West Road. Leaflets available from the Library

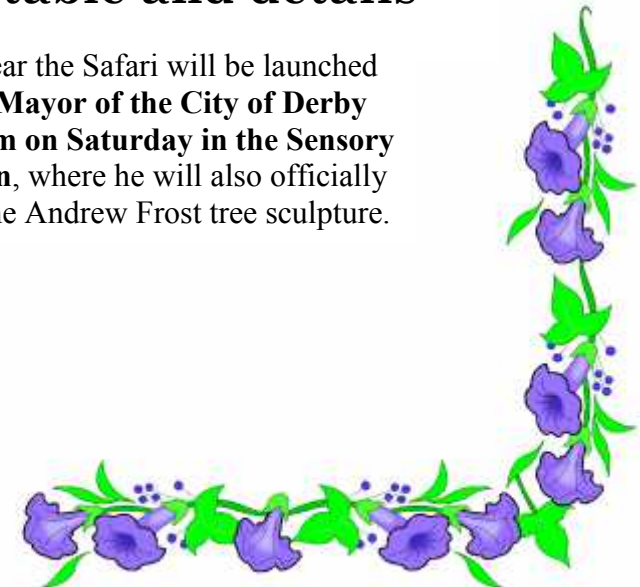

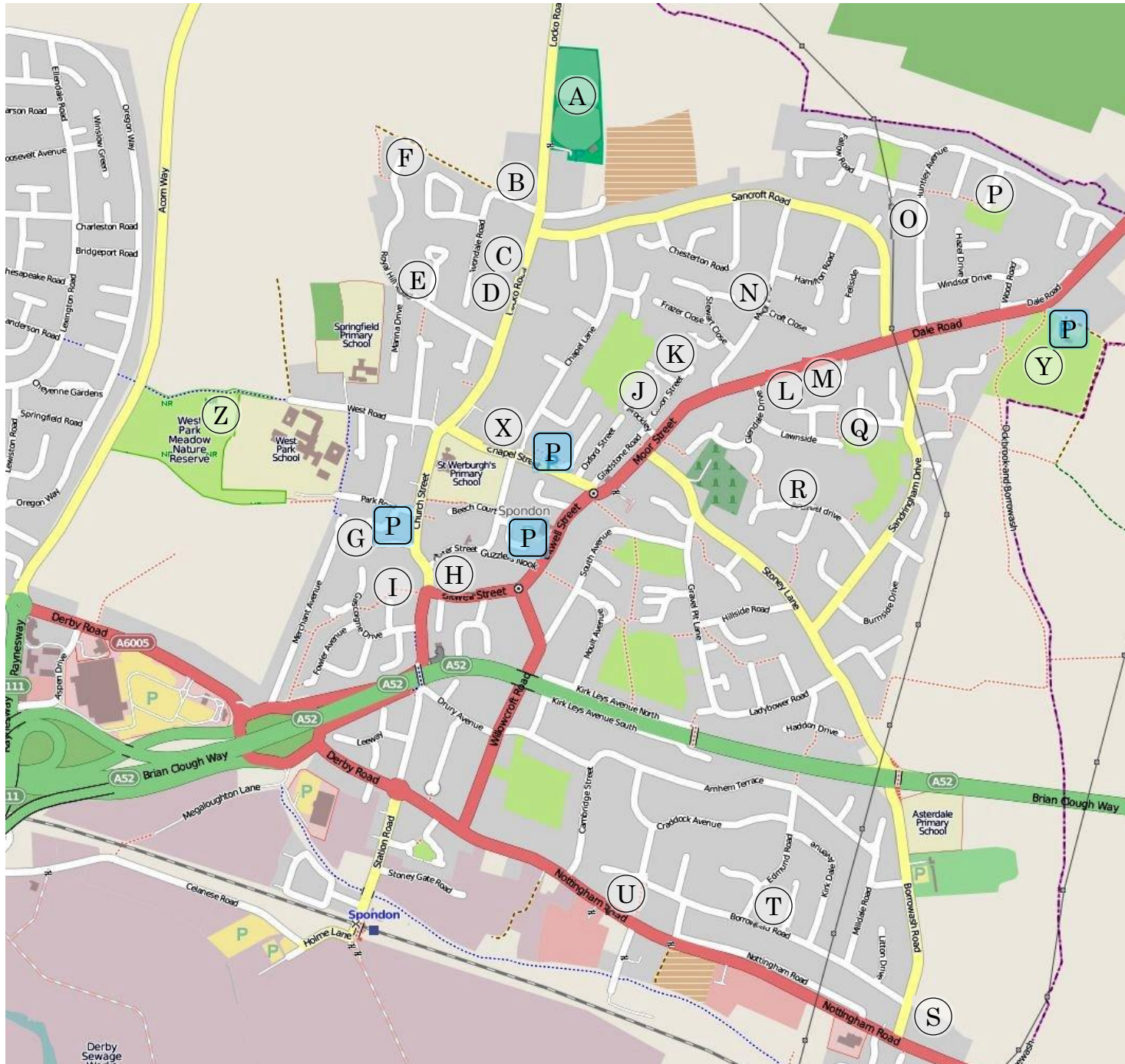
